Mobile Phones Policy – out of courtesy to the other patrons you are requested not to make or receive calls either in the club house bars/ restaurants or on the golf courses.

An 'appropriate' dress code applies to the club house and courses also – while in the clubhouse area please wear appropriate clothing. Jeans are not allowed on the courses, please wear tailored shorts and sleeved shirts only.

Showers are strictly for use of golfers only – beach clients please use the new shower provided at the steps to the beach.

The beach access steps are privately owned – management reserve the right to refuse access at any time to the beach by those steps.

Bikes – please do not ride bikes on the access path from the village to the club house, out of courtesy to all our golfers and for safety reasons. Clients using this access are asked to be as quiet as possible also.

Bikes can only be neatly parked along the wall outside the clubhouse, please do not 'clog up' the pro shop area on the top of the steps – accidents have occurred in the past, you could be liable.

Unless necessary, please don't bring bikes up to the clubhouse / beach area as the path is for walking only.

Parents must control their children at all times while in the clubhouse or its surroundings. Please don't embarrass us by having to ask you to leave this area if your child is walking/running around unattended. Please respect the rights of others to enjoy the use of these areas.

Golf – there are golf camps and competitions organised for our junior members. Green fees can be bought at discount rates.

Anyone found not paying green fees on any of the golf courses, who is not a member, will be barred from any further play on the course immediately.

A Course Ranger will be on duty until 10pm each day.

Driving Range Area- this facility will be strictly supervised by the Ranger at all times. Anyone found abusing this facility e.g. using drivers, picking up balls etc will be barred from any further use of the facility.
